1 Cor. 11: 23-26

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

5 Aspects of the Lord's Supper

1) Instruction – v.23
“For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread...”

5 Aspects of the Lord's Supper

2) Commemoration – v.24-25

“... and when He had given thanks, He broke it, and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same way He took the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

5 Aspects of the Lord's Supper

3) Proclamation – v.26

“For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.”

Colossians 3:3

“ For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.”

5 Aspects of the Lord's Supper

4) Participation –

1 Cor. 10: 16-17 (ESV)

“The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.”

1 Cor. 10:19-21 (ESV)

“What do I imply then? That food offered to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything?

No, I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons. You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons.”

5 Aspects of the Lord's Supper

5) Anticipation – v.26

“For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.”

Matthew 26: 29

"But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."

Luke 13:28-29

"... there when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, but yourselves being cast out. And they will come from east and west, and from north and south, and will recline at the table in the kingdom of God."

Revelation 19:7,9

"Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready." Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.'" And he said to me, "These are true words of God."
